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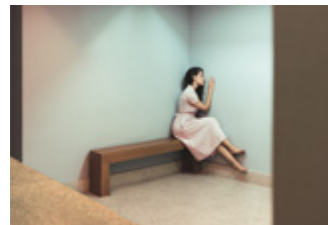
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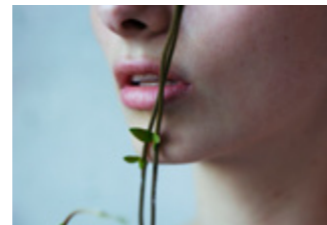
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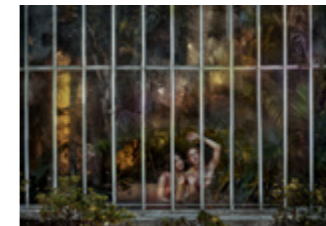
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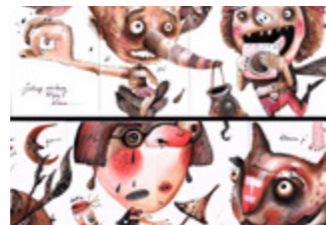
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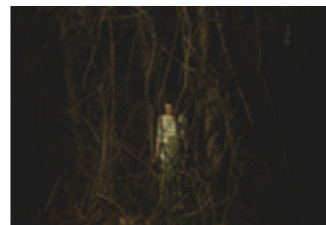
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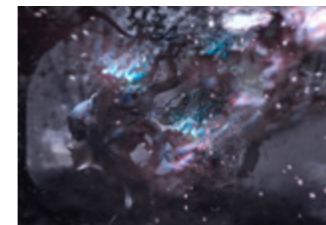
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ANDY MCFLY

Andy McFly is the amount of Simona Iamonte, She's a twenty-five years old female artist and illustrator from Torino, Italy. After her studies in the arts field, she decided to pursue a freelance illustrator career that is taking root even in the field of visual arts. Since a couple of years, she works and collaborates closely with independent shops of various kinds, musical associations and especially musicians. Working with the musicians for her, it is satisfactory as it creates a certain feeling and a lot of mutual trust, in which the two sides are in harmony to create something great and to give shape to the sounds. Her art is very feminine, but also consciously masculine, composed of bright and bold colors that embody the feelings and states of mind of existence. Focuses her artistic research, in the rediscovery of sexuality and vitality of the body in relation to the soul and essence of the human being (especially the female figure, as sinuous, charming and exciting): glances, movements, poses, parts of the body, generate awareness meanings and extreme aesthetic beauty. Her illustrations are a concentrate of vitality, colorful and elaborate and eccentric pattern. The techniques she uses are many and range from analog collage to painting, from photography to watercolor; no limits to her creativity, techniques are the means of his artistic conscience, it poured on canvas, rather than on paper.

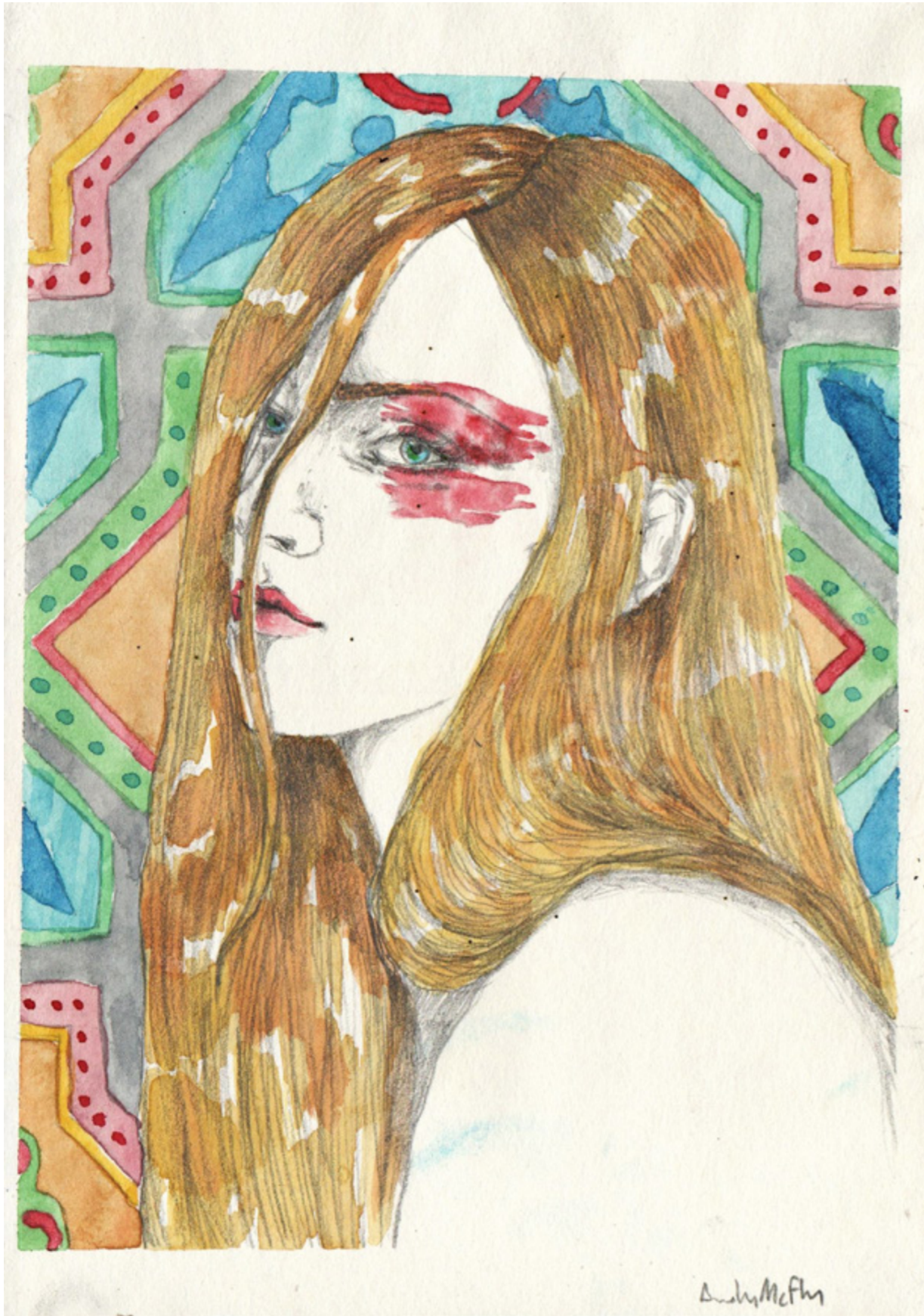
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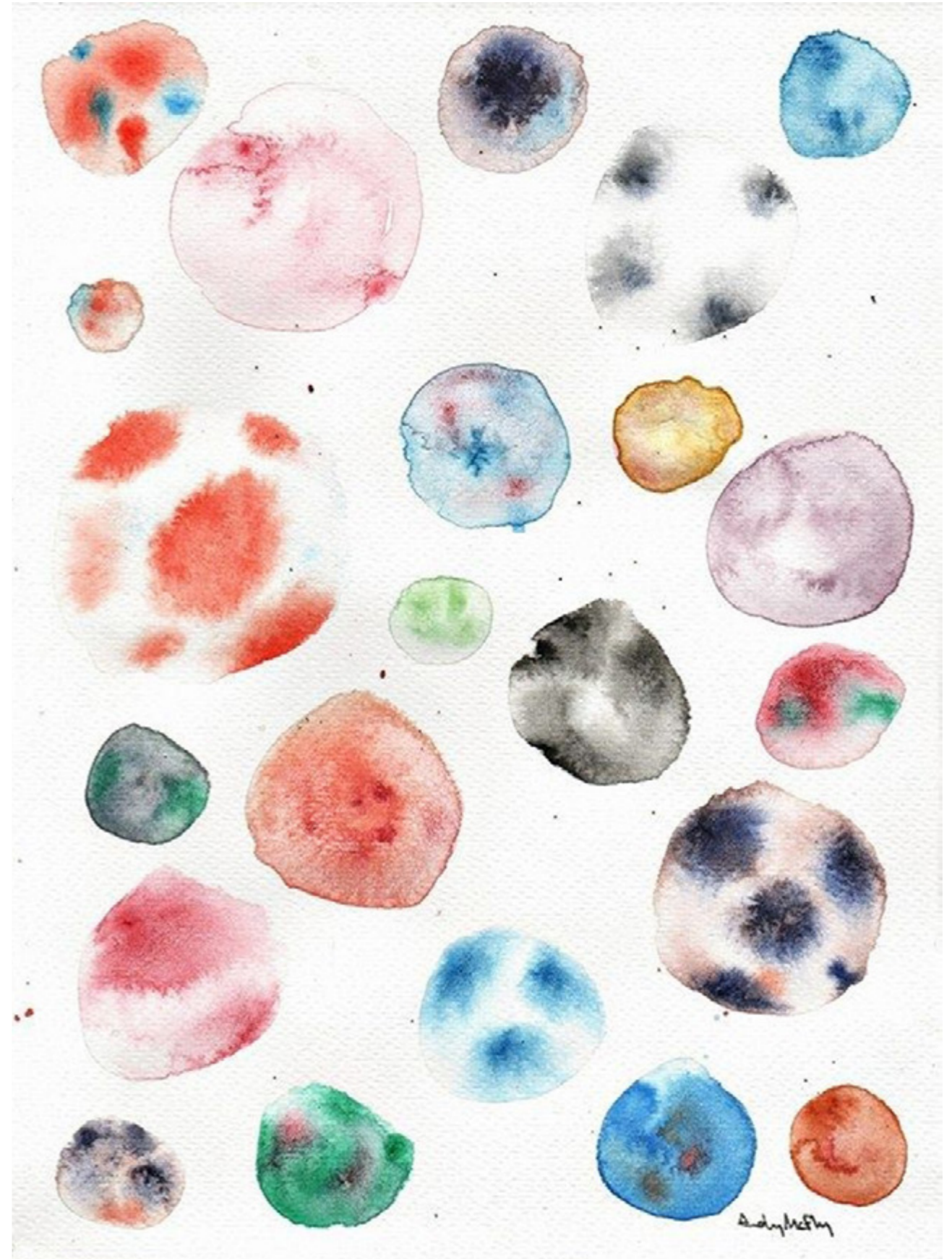

Claire Droppert is a photographer based in Rotterdam, The Netherlands. For many avid followers of Instagram, she is also known as @claireonline. Since starting her Instagram feed in 2010, her followers have steadily grown to more than 300.000. Within her theme 'Sounds of Silence', subjects like travel, nature and lifestyle are common aspects on her feed. Photography

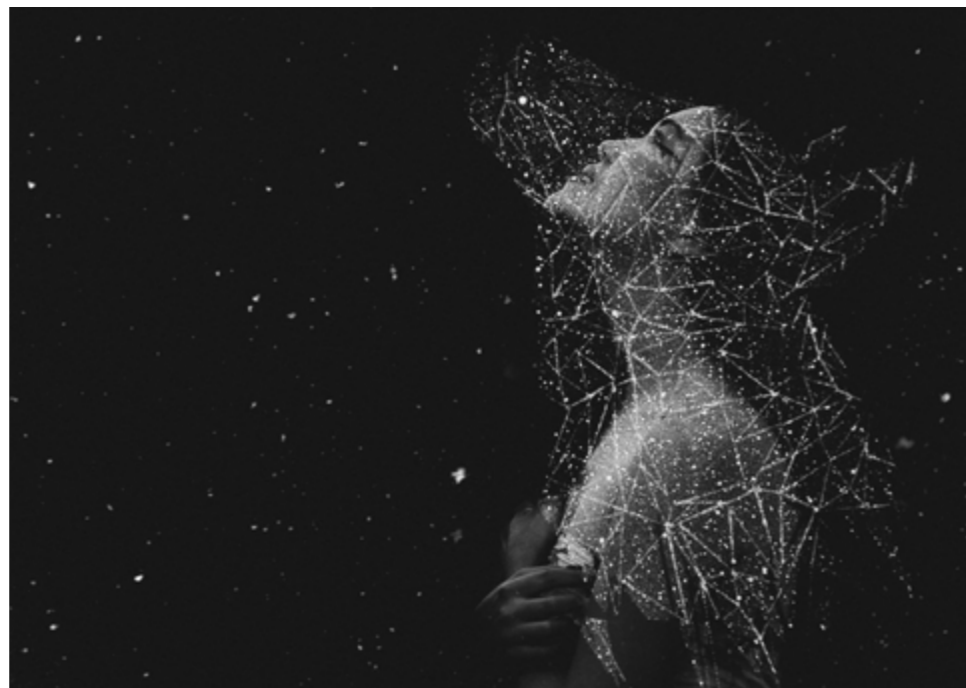
NÁDIA MARIA

Photography

Born in 1984, Nádia Maria is a Brazilian photographer based in Bauru, São Paulo, who started to photograph as a child at the age of 7, by taking photographs of her dolls. Over the years she explored photography, and has studied at Senac school in Brazil. Her relationship with the camera and the images she captures were also born in her childhood, but she became even more involved in her youth. Her photographs stem from her own reflections, from her desire to communicate and create freely and became a personal journal of her innermost thoughts and emotions; a window into her subconscious, letting her inspirations find her and delving into the depths of the human psyche. Nádia Maria describes her work as her poetry, the photos as the poems. Like good poetry, each photo extends beyond Nádia's own life and explores universal themes, such as the melancholy, the void, love, postpartum depression, the constant deconstruction and reconstruction of ourselves, and so on. With her ethereal works she explores the intricacies of the subconscious mind with compositions that arouse her viewers into "song, rhyme, and verse" to set catharsis in motion. Her poetic and unique works has taken the world by storm, with numerous publications and exhibitions by many countries and has picked up the attention of publications like National Geographic, Vanity Fair, Juxtapoz and Vogue. She was also considered one of the masters of photography of the new generation by Fashion Industry Broadcast. Nádia Maria's images convey a plethora of emotions with dreamlike qualities and make us feel like we are floating in and out of consciousness. And as herself says, her photographs tells a story already finished, which we still don't know the beginning and the end.

Who is Emi Haze?

I'm an Italian digital artist and illustrator with a strongest passion for art and painting connected to technology. My digital works are a mixture of graphic elements and hand-drawn ink marks, acrylic or watercolor stains. Photoshop gave me the chance to combine drawing, painting and photography together to make my dreams and ideas come true. In my works the human being melt with nature and its four elements to give birth to my inner world, ethereal and imaginative, hanging in balance between reality, dream and fantasy, in which color and sensitivity have the predominant role. Harmony that binds man and nature in a perfect way and which unfortunately nowadays seems to be a utopia. Piles of tree branches, clouds forming hair, faces that melt with air and sky, human silhouettes that arise from expanses of earth and roots... this is my visionary world. I've worked for several clients and big agencies like Adobe, Wacom, Penguin Random House, Microsoft, Getty Images. Recently, I collaborated with the agency Goodby, Silverstein & Partners of San Francisco and Adobe to be part of the Adobe Photoshop 25th anniversary "Dream On" Oscars Spot which was featured during the Academy Award Oscars 2015 ceremony and was part of an international bigger campaign.

What tools do you use?

Photoshop is my main working software. If it hadn't exist my works wouldn't have probably been real and would have existed only in my mind or, at least, they couldn't have been as they appear today. I use an iMac with an external display in my studio but my favorite and best tool is the Wacom Cintiq. It's my digital canvas, the place where my ideas come true, drawing directly on a display makes a more natural and speedier workflow. Before working into digital art and illustration I began with drawing, painting and later graphics. When I start developing an image I try to include my manual skill in the sign and in the use of color digitally importing it into my artwork. I combine in a single image, hundreds of Photoshop layers with many and many graphic elements and textures. Using the blending modes, layer masks, adjustments layers the starting image becomes less digital and more similar to a painting or a drawing.

Where do you get your inspiration?

I love Impressionism for the use of colour and Surrealism for the subjects. I could name many artists, painters and digital artists that have influenced me, at first in my painting and later in my digital art. Mentioning only a few of them would be reductive, because all the art world is the fundamental source of inspiration in the creative process, and I'm referring not only to pictorial art but also to music, filmmaking, photography and fashion. In my opinion, everything in every moment has an artistic side, the aesthetics of things, people around me. For me everything has its own importance, images, textures, sounds, fragrances, my creativity is constantly stimulated. Music is one of the keys of my creative process. Listening to my favorite artists like Sigur Rós, Radiohead, Bjork, helps me to immerse myself in my creative world and to have a right inspiration mood to develop a new work.

Any good advice?

The advice I would give is to have patience but be persistent, have an open mind and try to always inspire your creativity.

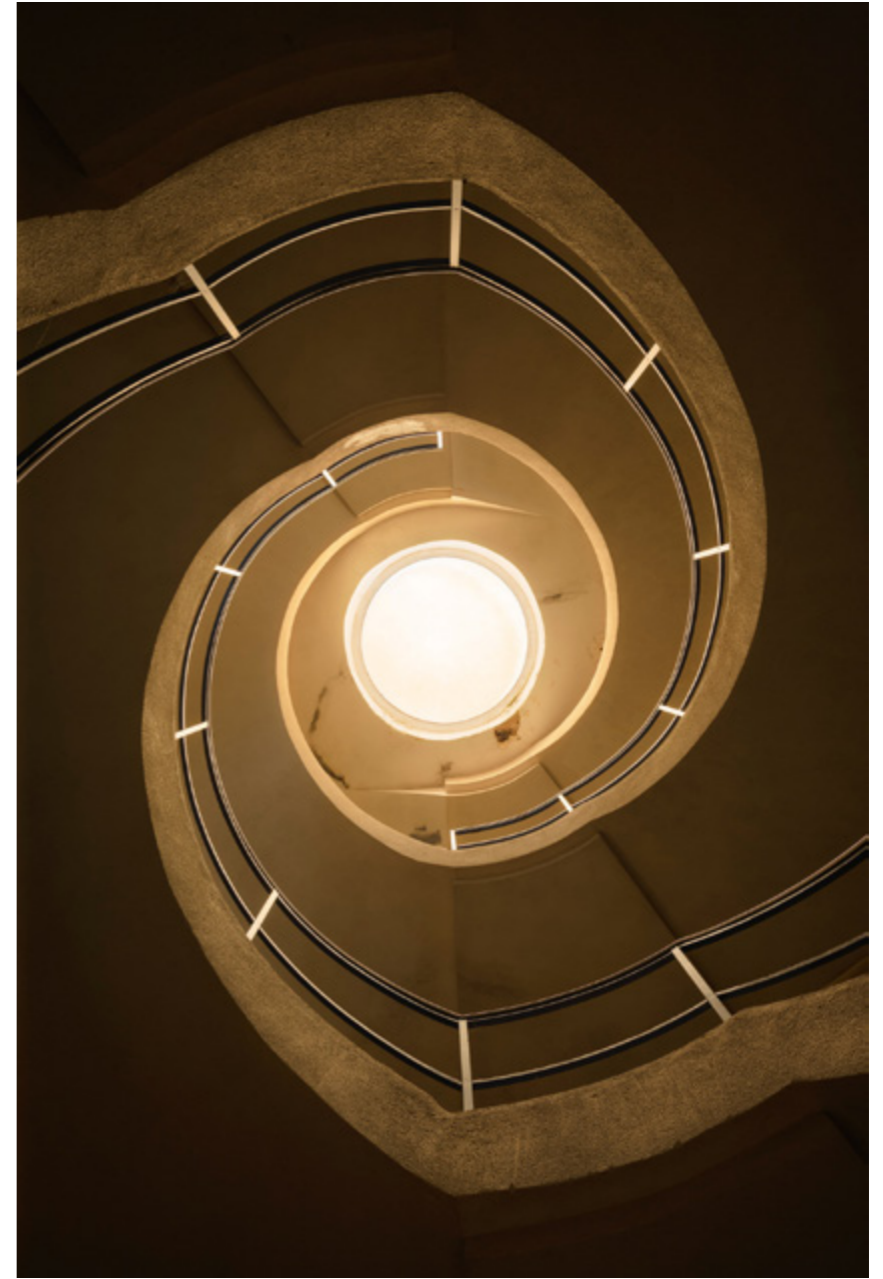

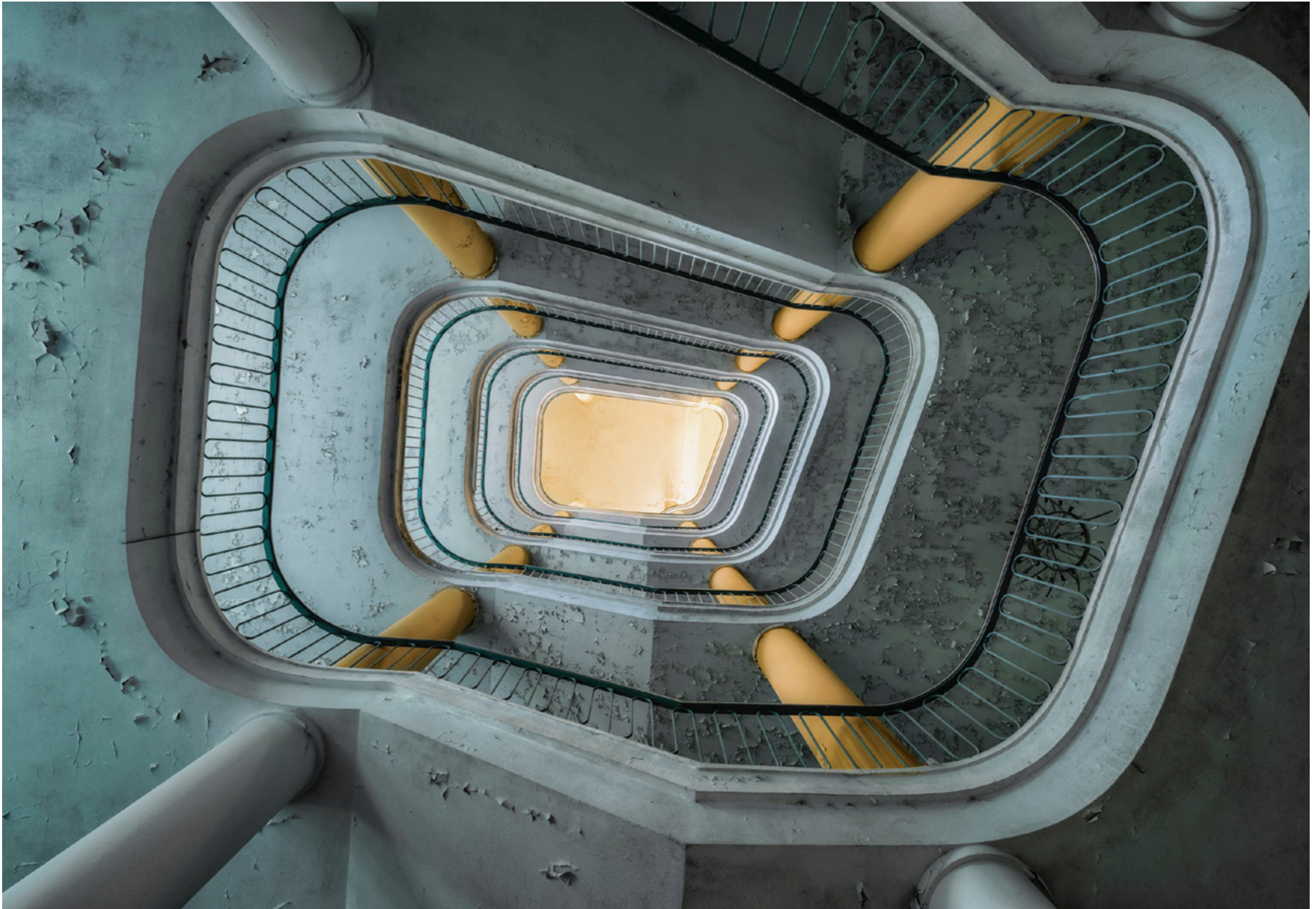

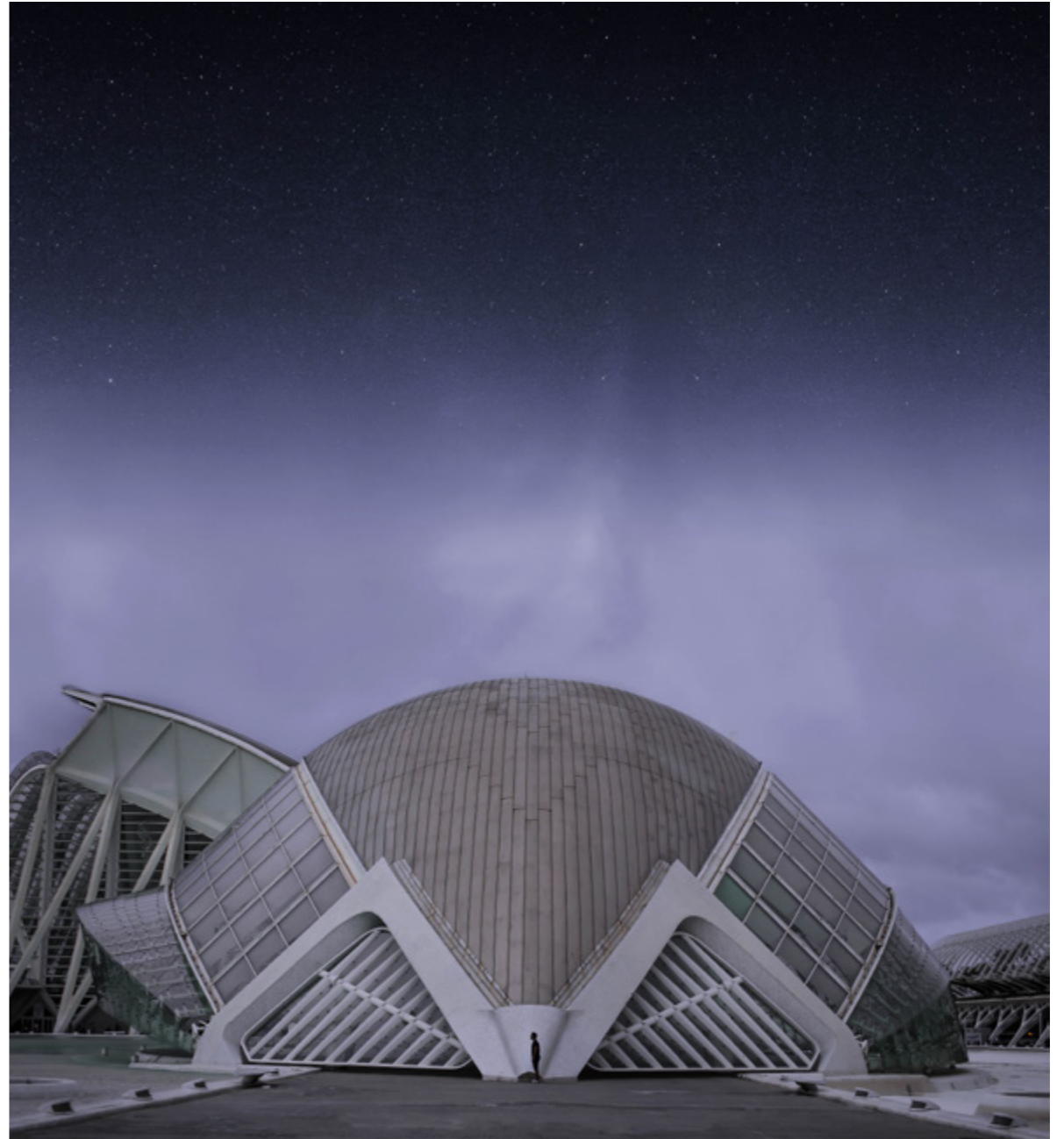

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RALPH GRÄF

Photography

In fall 2006, his scientific career as a cell biologist brought Ralph Gräf from Munich to Potsdam near Berlin. Photography has escorted him through his whole adulthood. Yet, it was his move to Potsdam that triggered a more intensive involvement with photography, since here he found friends in the local photo club who gave him a great creative environment to spend a huge part of his spare time for his creative talents. It is his medium to act out those of his creative talents that he has to neglect at his daily work. Together with ten of his friends he is organizing the "Photo gallery Potsdam", a successful gallery project to promote contemporary artistic photography. With his photos he wants to stimulate the imagination of the viewer and to tell a story that emotionally touches him, since sensing emotions is the prerequisite to keep pictures sticking in the viewer's mind. He prefers available light and clearly composed pictures with a discreetly arranged motive. He likes working with a series concept in mind that makes the photos more suitable for exhibitions and photo books. He uses digital cameras and analog medium format cameras with a wide range of lenses ranging from extreme wide-angle to telephoto and plastic lenses, and almost always a tripod. Yet, to him the type of camera used to take the picture is usually unimportant. The most important factor is always found behind the viewfinder. He feels that it is difficult to state names of other artists, who have inspired him, since there are many. He thinks one could get inspirations by any picture watched. He tries not to copy somebody else's style but to find and create an own one. Among his favorite photographers are Gregory Crewdson, Nadav Kander, Josef Hoflehner, Andreas Gursky, Wim Wenders and Petr Lovigin, just to name a few. Since 2010 he presented his photographic projects in fourteen well-acclaimed exhibitions in Berlin, Potsdam, Munich, Neubrandenburg, Milano (Italy) and Gorzów Wielkopolski (Poland). At the 4th "Kunstallee Potsdam" (an arts fair) in 2011, he won the Arts Prize for his series "The Traveller" in an election of the approximately 4000 visitors. Several of his photos won prizes or were shortlisted in national and international photo contests. All his projects are displayed on his website.

Series: The Traveller

The project started in March 2010 with on a tour with friends when we found the old brown suitcase in a bunch of bulk waste on the street. This old suitcase and the end-of-time-feeling of the partially abandoned village where we found the suitcase fueled my imaginations of the figure of a traveller in time, who finds himself in various, sometimes odd situations. In order so serve as a connecting element in a series of pictures the traveller required a high recognition value, especially since he often appears only as a small eye-catcher. Thus I have created the archetypal and nostalgic figure of a man wearing a suit and a hat, who carries a suitcase and an umbrella. For the sake of convenience, the protagonist of the series is myself, since this model is always available. Thus, all pictures were taken using an interval self-timer. I started the series with settings in the context of travel and traffic. Yet, soon I broadened the scope of the term "travel" to being on the way in unusual places or through passed times. The fact that my traveller usually finds himself somehow out of place in his surrounding creates suspense. Since he always retains his composure even in bizarre situations, the pictures sometimes acquire a funny aspect that keeps the photos sticking in the mind of the viewer. Although often appearing only as a small person "The Traveller" is always the eye-catcher of the photo and enhances the attention of the viewer for the scenery he is acting in. The individual images of the series are in no consecutive sequence. Each image should tell its own story and evoke different emotions in the viewer.

Valentina Brostean (born in Novi Sad, Serbia, in 1983) graduated from Faculty of Fine Arts Novi Sad, holds the BFA degree in graphic design and MFA degree in Illustration and Book design. Valentina Brostean is multi-disciplinary visual artist. Her work is figurative and surreal, expressed in various mediums across many fields of visual art. After Graduation on Master studies she covered the role of teaching assistant on the Illustration department on Academy of Arts Novi Sad. Throughout this period she started to explore and study traditional painting as medium, translating her eclectic illustrative style onto the canvas. Since 2006 to nowadays she has exhibited widely in personal and group exhibitions throughout Europe: Serbia, Italy, Great Britain, Germany etc, Middle East: UAE and the United States. Her artistic practice is related to different art sectors, ranging from fields of culture (curated gallery exhibitions on international level) to illustration and graphic design. She's specialized in illustration for children and adults, magazine editorials & character design - using both traditional media as well as software and the latest technology. She works mainly from subconscious imagery. Over the years she has been strongly inspired by people, animals, nature, dreams as well as urban culture, surrealism movement and street art. Combining all these elements she has developed her own, very personal, technique and style - the result of a perpetual journey, a constant search for identity and complexity of meanings. 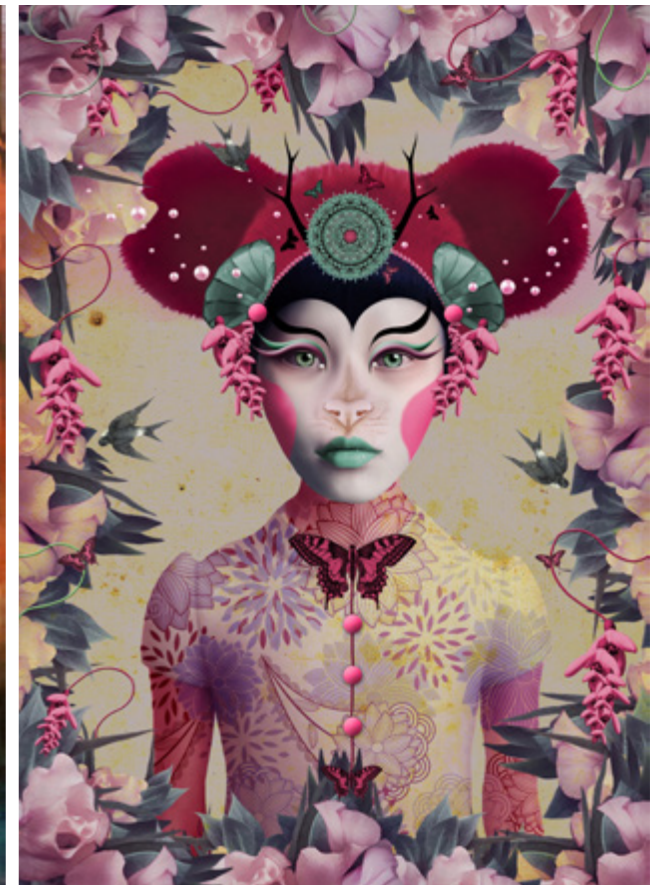

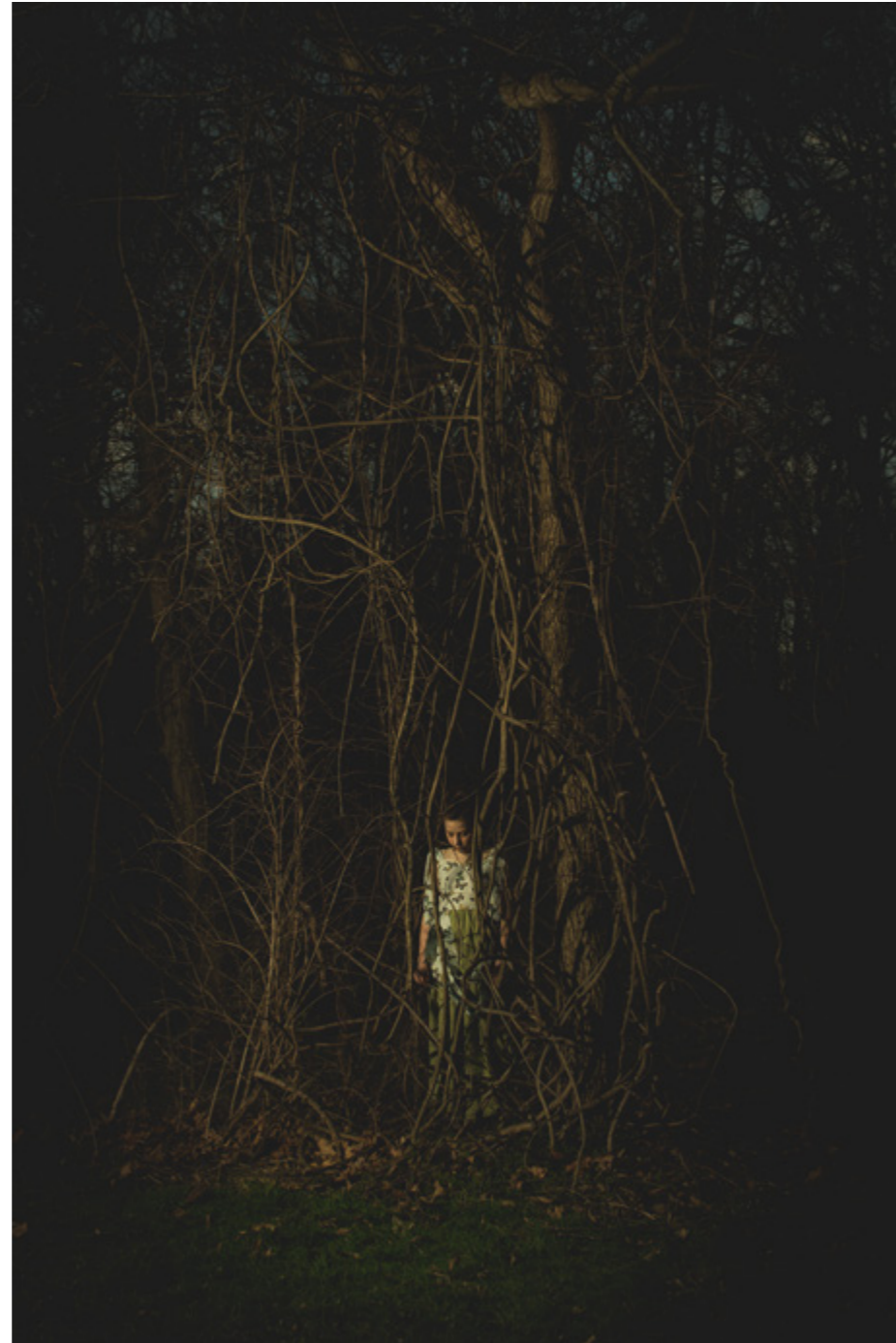
THOMAS H.P. JERUSALEM
