
Ekaterina Busygina




KALEIDOSCOPE ON THE 8 HILLS










After gathering some information about what the next season might deal with, I sat down with the team to outline the ideas of our tribute. As can be seen in the pictures, we decided to focus on characters that played in the first two seasons – and added some imaginary parts to the cast. The series consists of ten pictures that are currently part of a solo exhibition at März Gallery, Berlin. The show is on until 30th July and will thereafter move to Vienna and Florence.







Lorenzo Della Ragione








Pierre Kleinhouse
