
### **Grand Winner**

#### What inspires you in your work?

#### Can you tell us more about the winning shot?


Most of my studio work has a bit of a dark theme, so I wanted to do something colourful and different, while still keeping a bit of the darkness that is present in many of my images. That is pretty much what I told the hair & makeup artist I worked with, and this winning shot is a result of her incredible skill and creativity, combined with my lighting, composition, and post processing. The light is from a single soft box placed directly above the model's head and pointing down.

#### Who is your gorgeous model?

The model is a friend of mine, who just happens to be super gorgeous.


#### Did you work with anyone else on this shot? Like mua, assistants?


I only worked with the model and a hair & makeup artist for this shoot.











#### Tell us more about your work, what is your favourite genre?


My favourite genre of photography is most definitely fashion & beauty. I just love collaborating with other creatives, and I get to meet so many interesting and talented people when shooting fashion or beauty portraits. I also enjoy landscape, product, and wedding photography.


#### Do you have a most favourite all-time shot?

Picking a favourite photo would be like picking a favourite child. They all have different things that I like about them.

#### Any advice for our readers or tips about creating this kind of shots?

Have a plan! Always come prepared to your shoot, and make sure that everyone involved is up to speed. Take a little extra time to see how light and shadow is falling on your model. Make sure you see the catch light in their eyes. Don't overcomplicate things. See how many ways you can light your subject using a single strobe, just by changing the height, angle, or distance of your light. Only when you're fully confident in your one light setup should you try to add another. Have fun, because what's the point if it's not fun?
