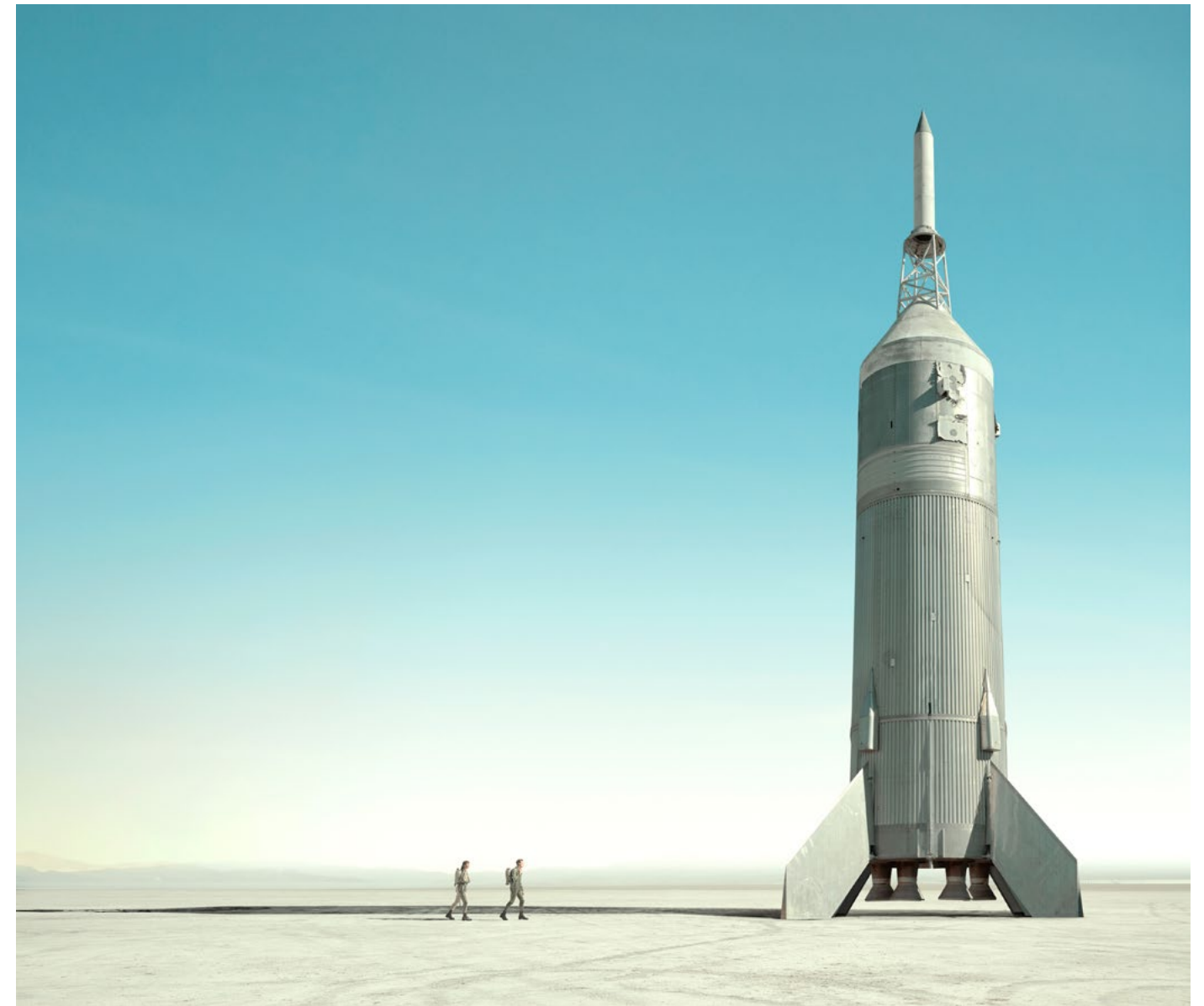
COLIN ANDERSON

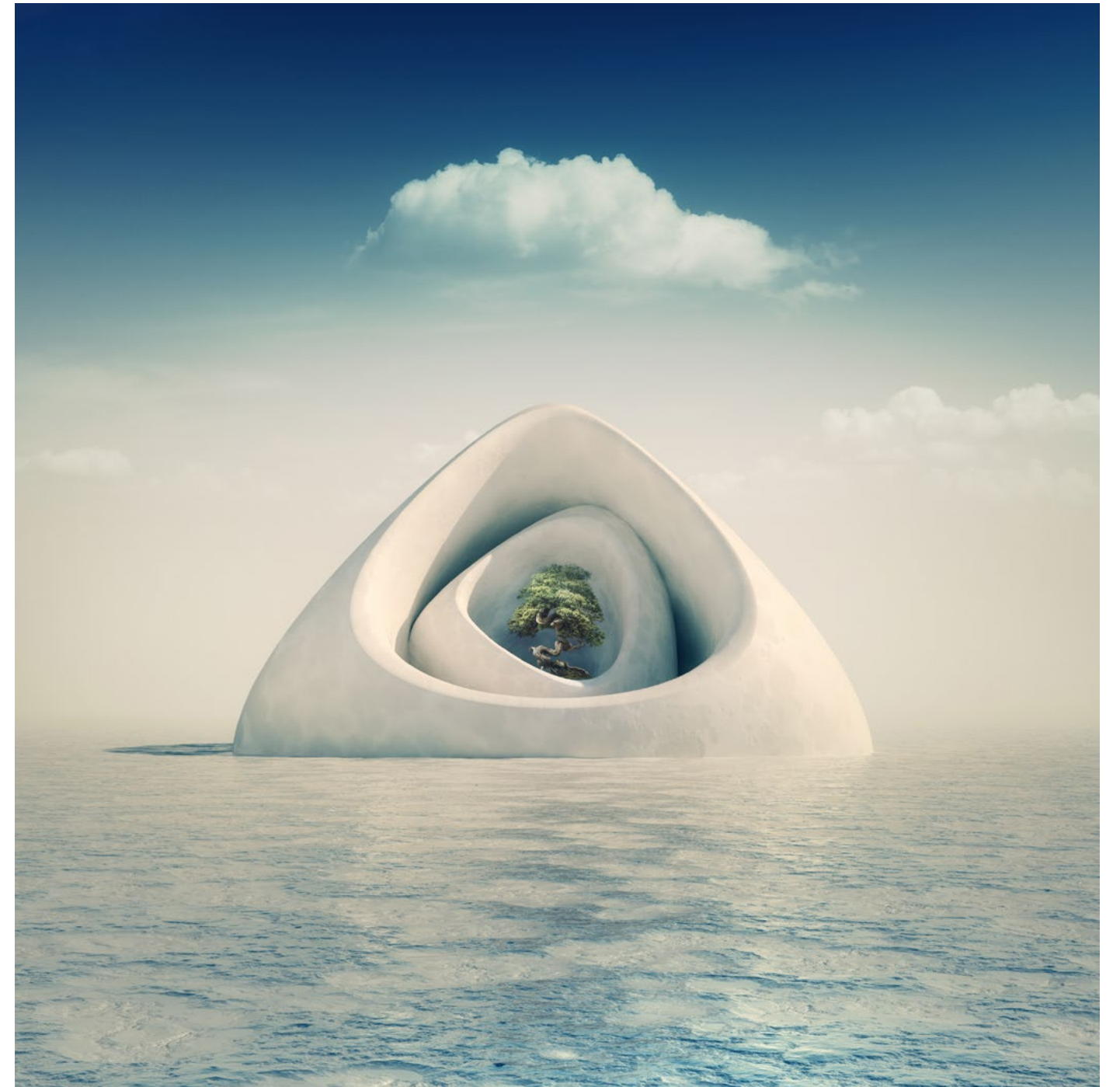

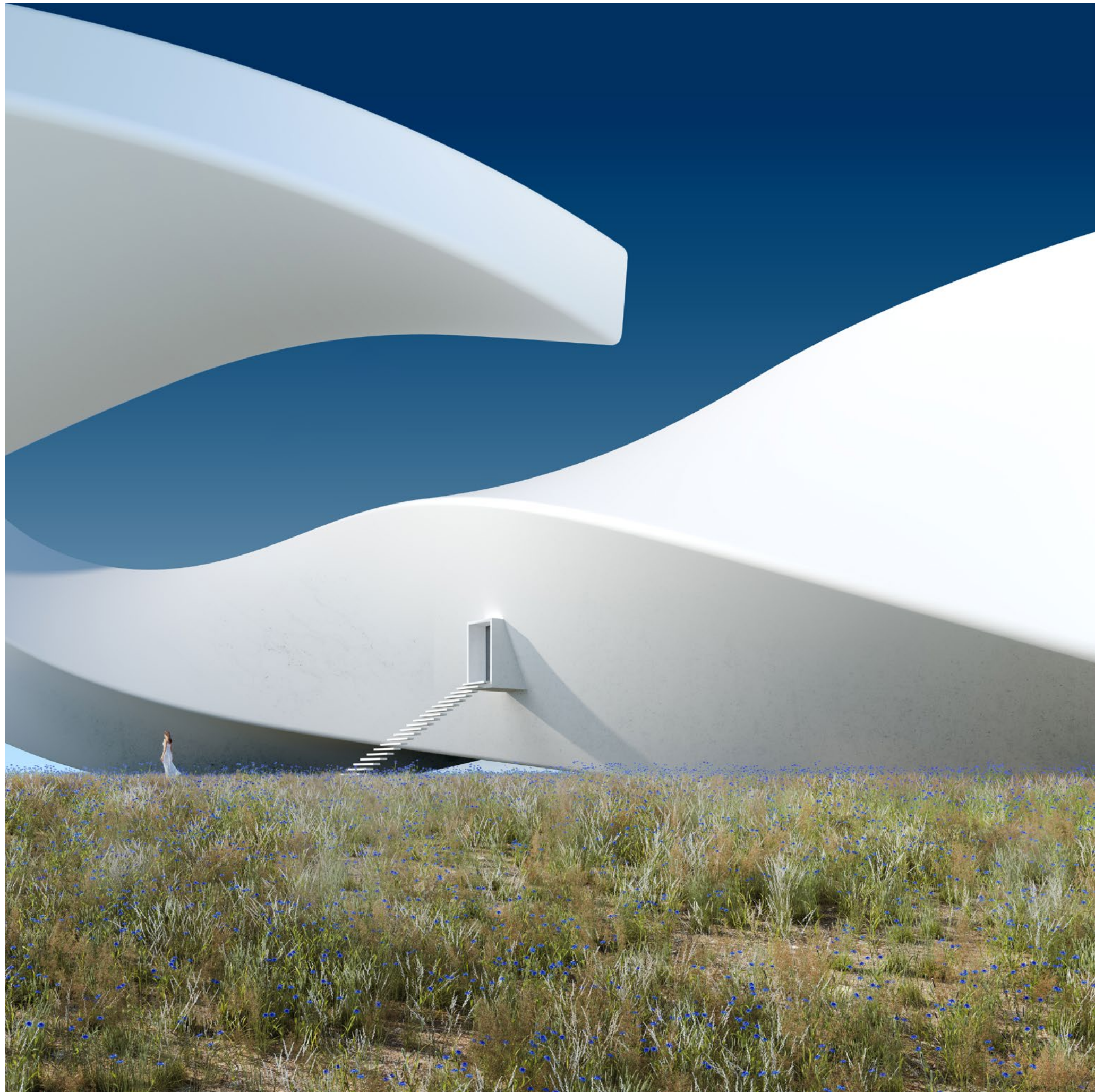

JOERI BORST

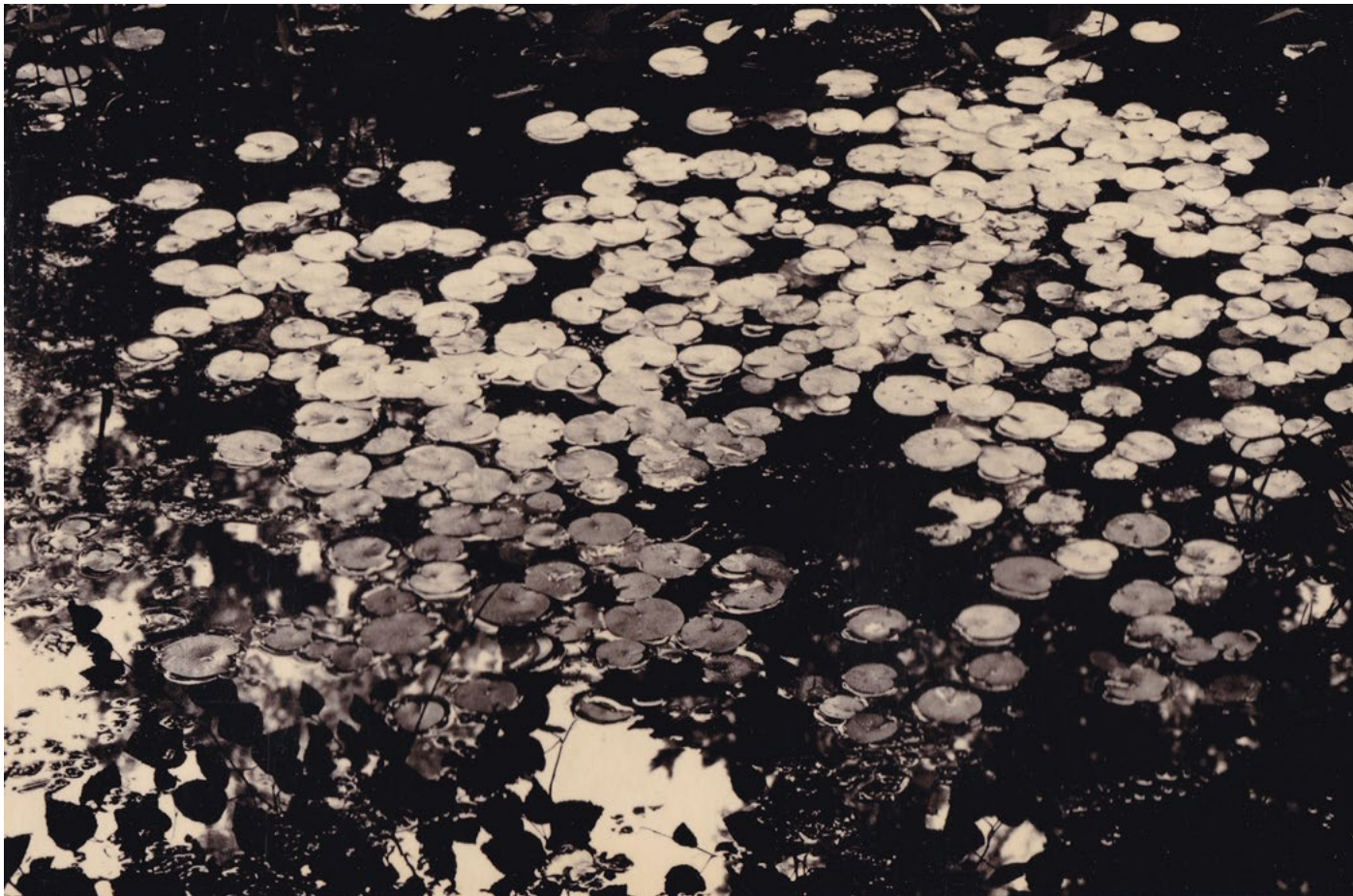
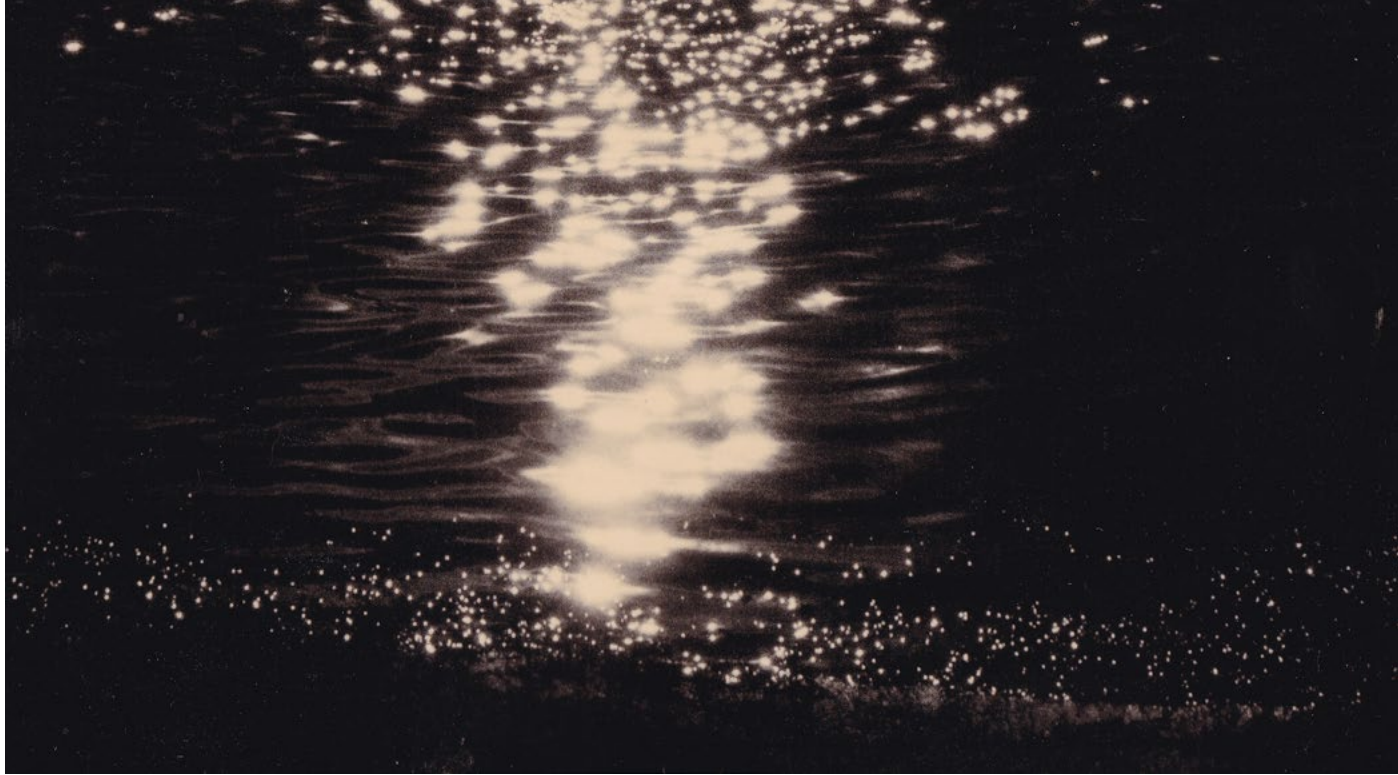

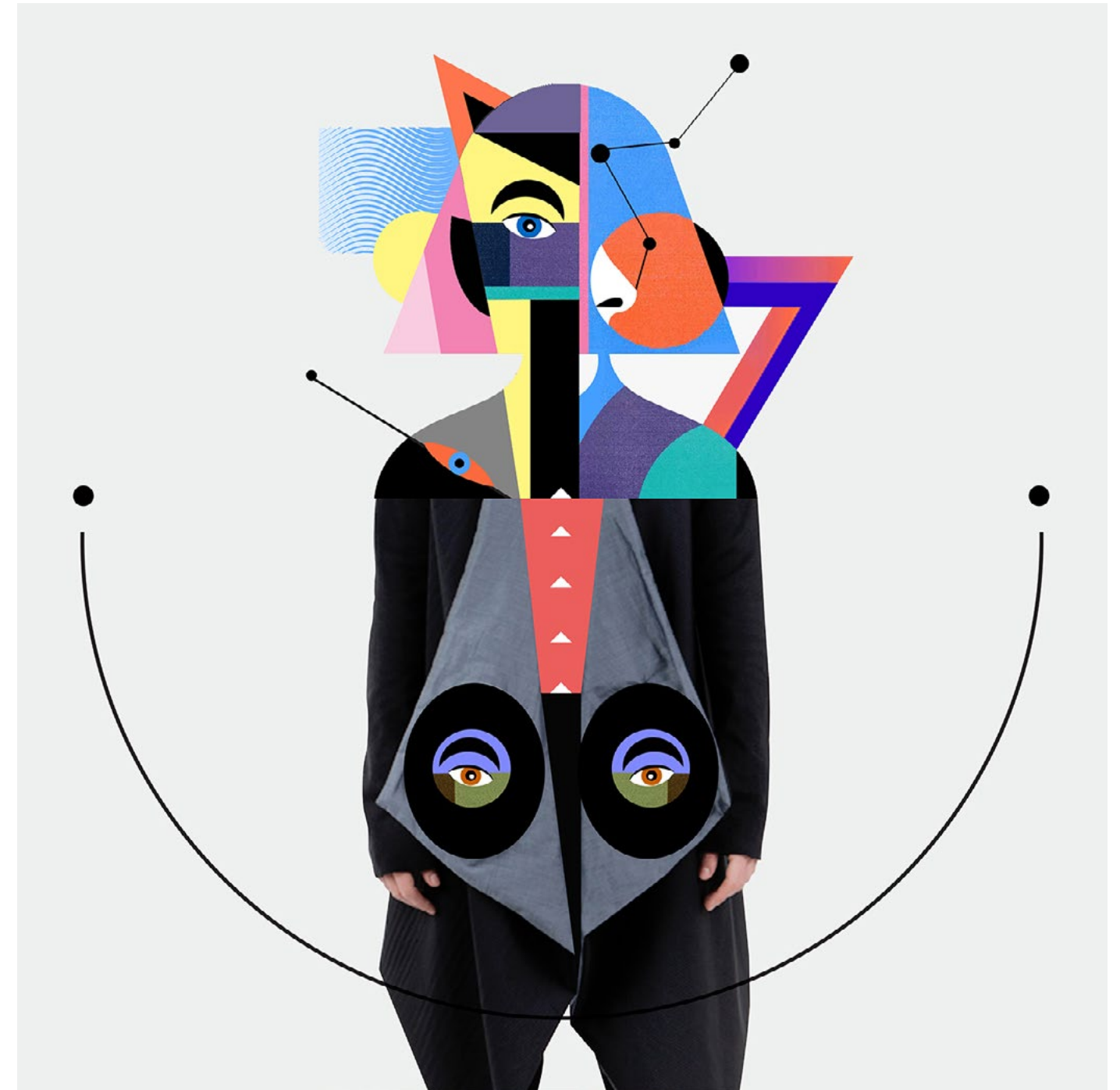
Multidisciplinary Visual Artist

VALENTINA BROSTEAN

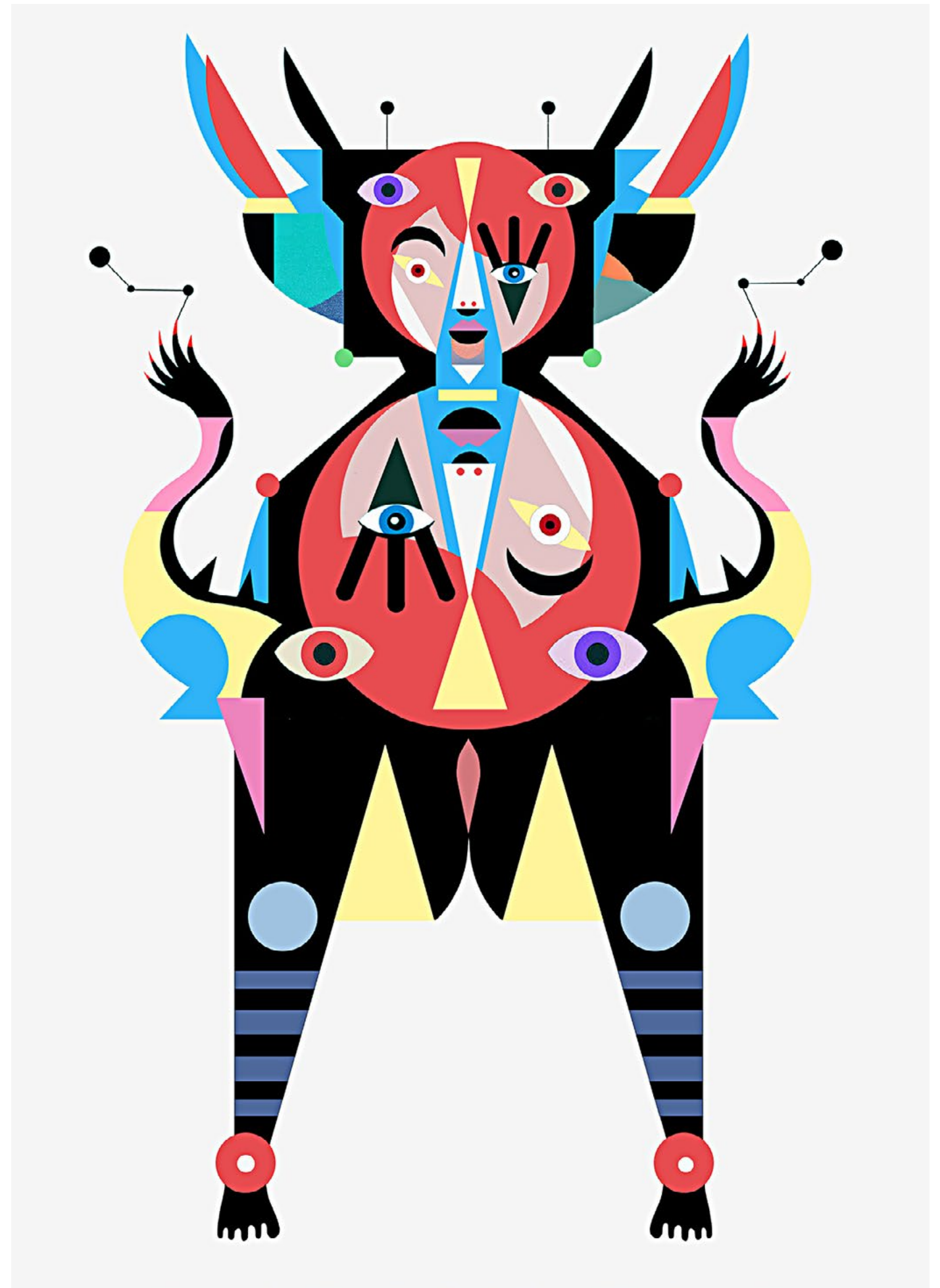
